Application Dates and Procedure

1. Application Period

The application period begins on February 25, 2026 and continues to May 14, 2026.

2. Method of Application

Applications and document uploading need to be done online.

Application Evaluation

1. The review is through written materials.

Grading items and criteria: a total score of 100 points includes academic performance and relevant information favorable for admission.

2. The admission committee establishes the admission criteria.

3. In cases where candidates have the same overall score, preference will be given to candidates with higher academic performance.

Admission Qualification Review

The admission applications are handled and qualification verification by the Office of Academic Affairs in AEUST. Those who pass the qualification the application materials are reviewed by the departments that the applicants applied and confirmation of assessment results. The final admission list would be made by the Admissions Committee in AEUST.

Language Proficiency

Mandarin Chinese is the major instructional language used in this school; applicants should be capable of listening, speaking, reading and writing in Mandarin Chinese.

Applicants should provide TOCFL (Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language) certificate for Level 2 (include) or above.

Financial Statement

Financial proof that shows financial sustainability for study within 3 months in Taiwan (USD 3,000 or more), or proof of full scholarship provided by a government agency, AEUST, or private organization.

Announcement of Application Results

1. Admission results will be announced at the school's Recruit website, and a letter of admission notification will be issued.
2. If you do not reply the intention for enrollment by the deadline, AEUST will consider you as voluntarily declining the offer of admission.
3. AEUST will send the Acceptance Letter to the mailing address provided in your online application system.

Accommodation and Living Expenses

1. Dormitory applications of international students (including overseas Chinese students, Mainland China students, and foreign students) will be examined and granted in accordance with AEUST Student Dormitory Counseling and Management Regulations. The following table displays the dormitory fees of Academic Year 115 (2026) :

Remarks :

1. All dormitory students have to pay NTD 1,000 for deposits per semester.
2. Air-conditioning fees will be charged and paid by a pre-paid card for each room.
3. Winter and summer vacation accommodation is charged separately, NT\$150 per day. Air-conditioning usage fee is not included.
4. The room assignments are arranged by Life guidance section of student affairs office, and the room type cannot be specified.

2. Living Expenses: Monthly expense at about NTD 6,000~10,000 required (excluding clothing, entertainment and transportation). Owing to different personal spending habits, living expense may vary slightly.

- Book expenses vary from course to course and should be paid according to the prices assigned by book publishers.

Remarks :

1. Admitted applicants must pay tuition and fees in accordance with the above table.
2. Extra fees
 - A. Information resources charge: NTD 800.
 - B. Student safety insurance fee: NTD 376.

The rules for fees and refund about Suspension, Withdrawal

1. Student applying for suspension or withdrawal from school before the registration date do not need to pay the fees; paid fees shall be refunded in their entirety.
2. Students applying for suspension or withdrawal since the next day of register to the day before school day, shall be refund 2/3 of tuition, all of the miscellaneous fees and other fees.
3. Students applying for suspension or withdrawal from school after the beginning of the class and within 1/3 of the semester, shall be refunded 2/3 of the sum of tuition and miscellaneous fees and other fees.
4. Students applying for suspension or withdrawal after classes lapse for more than 1/3

and less than 2/3 of the semester, shall be refunded 1/3 of the sum of tuition and miscellaneous fees and other fees.

5. Payments by student applying for suspension or withdrawal after classes lapse for more than 2/3 of the semester will not be refunded.
6. Students applying for suspension of study will not be refund the safety insurance fees; students applying withdrawal before paying the safety insurance to the insurance company, the refund will include the safety insurance. If the payment to the insurance company has already been paid, the refund will be processed after the insurance company authorised, students who has withdrew will not be eligible for insurance claims.

Scholarships and Financial Aid

International students may apply for “Taiwan Scholarship” granted by Taiwanese government at the ROC (Taiwan) institutes abroad prior to arrival in Taiwan. Please refer to the website of the Ministry of Education at <https://taiwanscholarship.moe.gov.tw/> for information about Taiwan scholarship.
