Language Proficiency

A TOCFL (Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language) certificate for Level 1(include) or above.

Financial Statement

Financial proof that shows financial sustainability for study within 3 months in Taiwan (USD 3,000 or more), or proof of full scholarship provided by a government agency, AEUST, or private organization.

Scores Calculation

1. The examination of students' admission qualification mainly includes examination of reviewing application documents and interview.
2. Interview will be conducted in on-site interviews. The time and place of interview will be announced by Email.
3. Evaluation (percentage & Description) :

Students with higher scores in interview have priority to be admitted if they have the same final scores.

4. Exam Result Announcement :

The Screening Committee will set the lowest scores for admission, and students whose scores are over the standard stand the chance to be formally enrolled. Those who fail to reach the standard will be put in the reserve list according to their scores.

Admission Results

2. Admission results will be announced at the school' s Recruit website, and a letter of admission notification will be issued.
3. If you do not reply the intention for enrollment by the deadline, AEUST will consider you as voluntarily declining the offer of admission.
4. Admission vacancies may be filled by students on the waiting list until reaching the required admission target.

If students are covered by Taiwan's National Health Insurance, relevant documentation should be provided. Insurance documents issued abroad must be verified by Taiwan's overseas missions. The university provides unified overseas injury and illness medical insurance, with a coverage period of six months about at NT\$3,474, or NT\$579 per month, included in the tuition fee payment form, to be paid by students during registration.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> National Health Insurance Fee: NT\$4,956 <p>According to the National Health Insurance Act, individuals holding residency permits and residing in Taiwan for at least six months are required to enroll in the National Health Insurance. The National Health Insurance fee for students (NT\$4,956 per semester) is included in the semester tuition and miscellaneous fees payment form as required by regulations, to be paid by students during registration. The National Health Insurance is a compulsory social insurance in Taiwan, and the school collects 6 months of health insurance premiums in advance each semester with students responsible for NT\$826 per month.</p>	

2. Accommodation

Students enrolled in the Special Overseas Program who require on-campus accommodation may apply according to the eligibility criteria and fee standards outlined in the AEUST Student Dormitory Counseling and Management Regulations.

Remarks :

1. All dormitory students have to pay NTD 1,000 for deposits per semester.
2. Air-conditioning fees will be charged and paid by a pre-paid card for each room.
3. Winter and summer vacation accommodation is charged separately, NT\$150 per day. Air-conditioning usage fee is not included.
4. AEUST requires all incoming international students who attend into International Bachelor Program of Industry-Academia Collaboration to live on-grounds ◦
5. The room assignments are arranged by Life guidance section of student affairs office, and the room type cannot specified.



The rules for fees and refund about Suspension, Withdrawal

1. Student applying for suspension or withdrawal from school before the registration date do not need to pay the fees; paid fees shall be refunded in their entirety.
2. Students applying for suspension or withdrawal since the next day of register to the day before school day, shall be refund 2/3 of tuition, all of the miscellaneous fees and other fees.
3. Students applying for suspension or withdrawal from school after the beginning of the class and within 1/3 of the semester, shall be refunded 2/3 of the sum of tuition and miscellaneous fees and other fees.
4. Students applying for suspension or withdrawal after classes lapse for more than 1/3 and less than 2/3 of the semester, shall be refunded 1/3 of the sum of tuition and miscellaneous fees and other fees.

5. Payments by student applying for suspension or withdrawal after classes lapse for more than 2/3 of the semester will not be refunded.
6. Students applying for suspension of study will not be refund the safety insurance fees; students applying withdrawal before paying the safety insurance to the insurance company, the refund will include the safety insurance. If the payment to the insurance company has already been paid, the refund will be processed after the insurance company authorised, students who has withdrew will not be eligible for insurance claims.

Related Information

1. **Applicants must have basic Chinese language skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing since the instructional language is mainly Chinese. The applicant should hold either a Chinese language proficiency certificate (TOCFL (Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language) certificate for Level 1(include) or above.)**

If the applicant fails to acquire an A2-level (TOCFL) Chinese language proficiency certificate at the time of enrollment, s/he must obtain the proficiency certificate before the end of his/her freshman year. If the applicant fails to do so, he/she is prohibited from advancing.

2. Those who have previously enrolled in the International Foundation Program (1+4 Program) but withdrew for any reason are not allowed to reapply for admission to the New Southbound Industry-Academia Collaboration International Program or the International Foundation Program (1+4 Program).
